CABARET COSTUMES

Costumes are hired to students for the production and are transported to the theatre by ADV and must be left at the theatre after the performance. A hire fee of \$15 to \$30 per costume charged in Term 2 to cover organisation and also dry cleaning of costumes plus new costumes that are purchased. A \$55 production fee applies to cover the cost of additional studio rehearsals, theatre rehearsals, teachers and staff for production and sets and props.

TICKETS: Tickets will be available via trybooking mid Term 2. Please note seating is allocated.

WHAT NEXT? It is assumed that all students in the listed classes will be available and present for the cabaret rehearsal and performance.
